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Introduction



In the implementation of the Cabinet Resolution No. (418) dated 25/07/1442 AH, approving the organization of the Digital Government Authority, which stipulates, in Article (3), that “the Authority shall be the entity competent in everything pertaining to digital government. It shall be deemed the national reference in its affairs and aims to regulate the works of the digital government in government agencies.” With reference to the provisions of Paragraph (Fifth) of Article (Four), amongst the tasks and duties of the Digital Government Authority are the following: “issuing measurements, indicators, tools, and reports to measure the performance of government agencies and their capabilities in the field of digital government, and the beneficiary’s satisfaction therewith.” Paragraph (Sixth) of the aforementioned Article also stipulates that the Authority “shall follow up on the commitment of government agencies to the resolutions and orders issued with regard to digital government transactions, in accordance with the frameworks and standards set by the Authority.”

This Report contains the results of the participating government agencies included in Qiyas 2022. The evaluation relied entirely on the data provided by the government agencies to the Authority through the Measurement System. The results shown in this Report represent the agencies’ commitment to the basic standards of digital transformation.


About Qiyas 2022



This Edition -Qiyas 2022- is a quantum leap in the measurement methodology. It establishes a shift from measuring maturity to measuring the extent of adherence to standards to improve the performance and effectiveness of government agencies, and to achieve the goals of Saudi Vision 2030.


The Authority issued the **Main Standards Document for Digital Transformation**, which includes two main sections. Section One: major standards document for digital transformation contained in Resolutions, Royal Orders, and Circulars. Section Two: Standards of Digital Transformation. The document also included relevant application requirements and levels of compliance with each standard.

Qiyas went through several stages, as shown in the figure below:



Concept of Digital Transformation

It is strategically transforming and developing business models to be digital models based on communication data, technologies, and networks.



What is Qiyas 2022?

It is an evaluation process based on a specific methodology aimed at government agencies to analyze their current situation and follow up on the development of their journey of digital transformation according to best practices and standards, thus contributing to achieving the goals of the Saudi Vision 2030.

Objectives of Qiyas



Improving levels of commitment of government agencies to orders and resolutions related to digital transformation.



Achieving the requirements of digital transformation through optimal application of the basic standards of digital transformation.



Developing the Digital Government.



Improving the performance and effectiveness of government agencies.



Improving the quality of services provided to beneficiaries.



Contributing to Saudi Arabia's progress in international indicators.

Method of Calculating Qiyas Index 2022


The Digital Transformation Measurement Index consists of two sub-indicators that measure the extent to which government agencies adhere to the basic standards of digital transformation, as follows:

First Indicator:

Standards derived from resolutions, royal orders, and circulars, containing **43 standards** according to their subjects, which are **12 subjects**.

Second Indicator:

The **68** digital transformation standards, which are divided into **19 themes**.



Compliance Levels

The levels of compliance with the standards are determined by the following levels of compliance:

	Full Compliance	Achieving compliance with all requirements of applying the standard.
	Partial Compliance	Failure to meeting one of the requirements, but meeting most of the standards.
	Non-Compliance	Failure to meeting a number of requirements for applying the standard.

Criteria for Nomination of Agencies Included in Qiyas 2022

Based on the **2022 Measurement Methodology**, the Digital Government Authority developed a set of standards to determine the segment of the target agencies for measurement. These standards include the following:

- 1) **The agency shall be a government Agency.**
- 2) **The entity shall be administratively independent and have a legal personality.**
- 3) **The entity shall be financially independent.**
- 4) **Newly-established Agencies by the Council of Ministers shall have 18 months elapsed since their establishment.**

Based on the above, **217 government agencies were measured, including 27 agencies** that participated for the first time in Qiyas 2022, and therefore their results are not calculated within the agencies covered in this Report.

As for the remaining **190 government agencies**, they will be detailed in this Report.


Classification of Government Agencies into Groups

Under the improved framework for Qiyas 2022, the Digital Government Authority used a specific classification of government agencies according to the nature of their work and the services they provide to beneficiaries in an aligned coherent manner. This classification allows for the possibility of comparison between such agencies in an effective and clear manner.




Comparison of Qiyas 2021 and 2022

The government agencies scored **80.96%** in Qiyas 2022, compared to Qiyas 2021, the Ninth Edition, with a rate of **69.39%**, as the progress rate reached **11.57%**. Below are the results of the agencies participating in Qiyas 2022 for Digital Transformation, namely **217 government agencies**.
