Saudi Arabia's Digital Leadership Regionally and Globally

- Saudi Vision 2030 has contributed to achieving many leaps in the field of digital government since its launch in 2015.
- Saudi Vision 2030, through specialized e-government initiatives, has raised the Saudi Arabia's ranking from 52nd to 6th place in a short period of time.
- Saudi Arabia, South Korea and Singapore are the only countries in the list of the top (ten) countries for e-government in the Asian continent.
- Saudi Arabia ranked (1) at the regional level, (2) at the level of the G20, and (6) at the level of 13 countries around the world.
- Saudi Arabia is ahead of all countries in the Middle East and enters alone in the list of the top ten countries in the world as the first country from the Middle East to enter this list.
- Saudi Arabia advanced to the second place among the G20, with a slight difference from South Korea, which ranks first, and outperforms all Western countries in the G20.
- Saudi Arabia's strong performance in the UN E-Government Development Index contributes to a strong assessment of the Asian continent.
- Saudi Arabia becomes a benchmark in the world in e-government practices.
- In 2022, Saudi Arabia jumped (12)
 places. In 2024, Saudi Arabia jumped (25) places.






What does Saudi Arabia's digital progress mean?

Saudi Arabia's digital transformation is undergoing a profound shift, reflecting the leadership's commitment to innovation and modernization under Vision 2030.

By advancing digital infrastructure, improving government efficiency, and fostering innovation, Saudi Arabia is building an integrated digital society for the future.

Saudi Arabia's progress in digital transformation is a key pillar of Vision 2030, aimed at creating a diverse and integrated digital economy.

This transformation enhances Saudi Arabia's ability to tackle global challenges, supports private sector growth, and improves government efficiency. Visible progress across digital indicators highlights continuous efforts to accelerate transformation, enhance government services, and improve quality of life for citizens and residents.



Saudi Arabia achievements in digital transformation

Global Ranking and Competitiveness Indicators

In 2021, Saudi Arabia achieved a major milestone by ranking second globally among G20 countries in the Digital Competitiveness Report by the European Center for Digital Competitiveness. This ranking reflects the strong support from the Saudi leadership and the ambitious projects undertaken to enhance digital infrastructure and develop digital capabilities.



Ranking in the Digital Government Index

Saudi Arabia jumped 23 places in the 2021 World Digital Government Rankings Survey, reflecting improvements in administrative and financial efficiency, enhanced quality of life for beneficiaries, and strengthened sustainable development goals. The results showcased Saudi Arabia's significant progress in innovation, integration, public engagement, digital regulations, and infrastructure.



Maturity of E-Government Services

In 2022, Saudi Arabia ranked first in the Government Electronic and Mobile Services Maturity Index (GEMS) Issued by the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia for Western Asia (ESCWA). This index measures the maturity of government services delivered through online portals and smart applications. Saudi Arabia excelled in this ranking, achieving a maturity rate of 93%.



Development of e-Government

Saudi Arabia achieved its highest historical ranking in the United Nations E-Government Development Index, advancing 12 places globally to reach 31st place in 2022. Saudi Arabia ranked among the leading nations in delivering government service information and open data to citizens and businesses, achieving a perfect rating of 100%. The report praised Saudi Arabia's exceptional performance across all areas of e-government development.



Regulatory and Legislative Initiatives

The report highlighted key aspects, including regulatory and legislative initiatives such as the 2023 ICT Sector Strategy, which builds on the roadmap for innovation and digital transformation. These initiatives include the establishment of the Saudi Data and Al Authority, the Digital Government Authority, and the National Digital Transformation Strategy.



Investment

In the investment sector, Saudi Arabia launched the Public Investment Fund to finance startups and emerging technologies, focusing on attracting foreign investments and global companies to enhance digital and technological knowledge. This investment aims to expand the IT and emerging technology market by 50%, create over 25,000 new jobs, and increase women's participation in the sector by 50%.

The Importance of Digital Transformation

What is the importance of digital transformation and its role in Saudi Arabia's national transformation?

Digital transformation of services in Saudi Arabia forms the foundation for the well-being and quality of life of its residents. It is a crucial step towards achieving the objectives of Vision 2030 by keeping pace with the rapid technological advancements globally and supporting sustainable development goals. Accelerating digital transformation of services and developing the digital infrastructure is not only vital for improving the lives of individuals and the community but also helps government entities in refining procedures, enhancing control, and enabling the measurement of progress and beneficiary satisfaction.

How do you assess digital transformation in Saudi Arabia, and how do we compare to other countries in this area?

Since the launch of Vision 2030, Saudi Arabia has made remarkable leaps in developing its digital infrastructure, expanding internet services, and strengthening cybersecurity. This year, Saudi Arabia achieved a global milestone by advancing 25 ranks in the United Nations e-Government Index, reaching 6th place, with Riyadh ranking 3rd among 193 cities worldwide for digital services. Additionally, Saudi Arabia achieved 100% in all criteria of the global cybersecurity index published in the IMD World Competitiveness Yearbook, reflecting Saudi Arabia's exceptional performance in embracing technology, fostering digital innovation, and ensuring cybersecurity.



Impact of the Digital Economy on Citizens

How can digital services enhance the quality of life for Saudi citizens?

We are witnessing, by the grace of Allah, a significant development in government services, making life easier for all segments of society. Government entities now provide 6,000 electronic services, representing 97% of total government services. These services include platforms such as "Absher," "Tawakkalna," "Najiz," electronic tourist visas, electronic powers of attorney, and many others that are available around the clock, anywhere, with the highest efficiency and reliability.

What benefits can an ordinary citizen gain from using digital services in their daily life?

Ease of access to government services through digital apps and platforms, saving time, effort, and money for all parties, and improving security and reliability in electronic transactions. One of the most successful stories of the National Transformation Program is the launch of the "Najiz" platform, which, by the end of 2023, provided more than 160 judicial services, eliminating the need for 65 million visits and saving approximately 90 million papers annually. This alleviates the burden on beneficiaries from visiting judicial facilities and allows them to complete their services with ease and convenience.

The Role of the National Transformation Program in Digital Transformation

What role does the National Transformation Program play in supporting digital transformation in Saudi Arabia?

The National Transformation Program aims to develop e-government services and promote the digital economy. In collaboration with the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology and the Digital Government Authority, the program has launched various initiatives to support the digital transformation of government services. These include the Digital Government Award and the annual release of digital transformation progress results. Thanks to the support of our wise leadership and the combined efforts of public, private, and non-profit sectors, we are witnessing continuous progress in improving and maturing our digital experience. This is regularly assessed for both service beneficiaries and officials, helping to enhance the beneficiary experience and ensure the best digital experience in a competitive and secure cyber environment, while also supporting entities in implementing optimal security practices to protect the interests of our beloved nation
